APPLYING FOR YOUR LICENSE

>To find the nearest DMV, use this website: www.cyberdriveillinois.com

If under 18 years of age, but at least 16, please make sure to have the following in your possession when applying for your license at the Department of Motor Vehicles (DMV):

- **Valid Instruction Permit** – Must have for nine months prior to licensing
- **School ID**
- **Birth Certificate** – Must be certified and cannot be a hospital birth certificate
- **Social Security Card** – Must bear your signature
- **Proof of Residency** – A postmarked envelope addressed to you is acceptable
- **50 Hour Driving Practice Log** - 10 of the 50 hours must be at night
- **Valid Insurance Card** – For vehicle you are using for your test

- Click on “**Parents/Students**”
- Scroll down to “**Driver Education**”
- Click on “**Student License Inquiry**”
- Enter **Permit Number** – No spaces or dashes – Begins with initial of last name
