HIGH SCHOOL ATHLETIC HALL OF FAME

Mission statement:

The Wheeling High School Hall of Fame Committee has developed a program of recognition designed to honor those individuals who through their commitment, sacrifice, and dedication to the Wheeling High School Athletic Program have brought pride and distinction to our school community as a player, coach, administrator, or active supporter.

Committee Membership:

The Hall of Fame Committee shall consist of the following members:

1. The current Assistant Principal for Student Activities.
2. The current boys and girls athletic directors
3. A current W.H.S. Administrator.
4. A former W.H.S. Administrator.
5. Two current representatives, one male and one female, of the W.H.S. Athletic Program.
6. Two members of the athletic community.

Guidelines:

Selection number:

1. Initially a maximum of five inductees for each of the first three years of the program. The committee will choose these five inductees.
2. A maximum of three inductees a year after the first three years.

Selection Eligibility:

1. Inductees will be limited to those who have been graduated from high school a minimum of ten years or have been retired from their athletic related position for a period of at least five years.
2. Nominations will be accepted for any athlete, coach, administrator or supporter who through their commitment, sacrifice, and dedication to the W.H.S. Athletic Program have brought pride and distinction to our school community.
3. The committee shall have the right to review and make exceptions to the above criteria for special circumstances.

Nomination process:

1. Nominations may be submitted by any supporter of W.H.S. athletics.
2. Nomination forms may be submitted at any time, but must be received prior to August 1 to be considered for induction in that next school year.
3. Once an individual has been nominated their file will remain active and they will continue to be considered for induction each year.
4. Nomination forms may be obtained from the Assistant Principals for Student Activities office.

Election process:

1. Each committee member will rate the nominees from all the nominees submitted, and rate them 5 to 1 (based on the criteria listed on the ballot).
2. The five nominees that receive the highest average ranking from the committee will be inducted into the Hall. (Up to 3 after the 1st 3 years)
3. The next five ranked nominees will be made a priority for the next year.

Induction Ceremony:

1. The inductees will be honored with a presentation at halftime of a basketball game followed by a cake and coffee reception for friends and relatives.
2. The inductee or a representative must attend the ceremony. If this is not possible, the Hall of Fame Committee will make the appropriate decision regarding the induction.
3. Each inductee will receive a small token of their induction and a plaque with their name, picture and accomplishments will be on display in the Hall, which will be located in the main foyer of Wheeling H.S.
